In order to apply for your Adult Student Visa under Tier 4 of the Points Based System you must quote the number of your

CAS (Certificate of Acceptance of Studies) on your visa application form

All applicants who have been issued with a CAS must inform us if they are not going to arrive by the start date of the programme. The start date of your programme is 1 October 2023. Please note, entry is permitted up to 6 October 2023 and you must inform us if you are going to be arriving later than the start of term. If you do not arrive by this date UWTSD has a responsibility to report your non arrival to the UKVI. This could affect your immigration record.
